- 2.2 The Hirer agrees not to exceed the maximum permitted number of people per room including the organisers and performers.

2.3 In order to hold a licensable activity on the premises or on part of the premises not covered by the Hall's Premises Licence, a Temporary Event Notice (TEN) will need to be given to the licensing authority.

The Hirer shall obtain the written consent of the Management Committee on the form provided for this purpose before giving the licensing authority a TEN. Failure to do so will result in cancellation of the hiring without compensation because there is a limit on the number of TENs which can be granted annually for any premises. Lack of co-operation could affect future fundraising by the Village Hall Management Committee and local voluntary organisations.

- 2.4 The Hirer agrees with the Village Hall to be present (by its authorised representative, if appropriate) during the hiring and to comply fully with this Hire Agreement.
- 2.5 It is hereby agreed that the Standard Conditions of Hire together with any additional conditions imposed under the Premises Licence (2.1) or that the Village Hall Management Committee deem necessary shall form part of the terms of this Hiring Agreement unless specifically excluded by agreement in writing between the Village Hall and the Hirer.
- 2.6 None of the provisions of this Agreement are intended to or will operate to confer any benefit pursuant to the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 on a person who is not named as a party to this Agreement.
